## DATABASE ROLLOVER - NOVEMBER 1

On the 1st of November, the LeagueNet Database will rollover to the 2017 Season, meaning clubs/associations will be able to start taking Registrations for the upcoming season! To prepare your club, the following tasks should be completed.

1. **IMPORTANT:** Ensure your club's products from previous seasons are made inactive/archived.
2. If your club has not done so, complete the [Payment Configuration](#) to ensure your Club can take Payments Online.
3. Create [New Products](#) for the 2017 Season.
4. Link your clubs 2017 Player Products (i.e. Registration fees), to the Registration form: "Club Player Registration Form (#53641)".
5. Within the Registration Form, re-set your Club's Registration Start and End Dates.
6. Update your Club's [Dashboard](#), including "Details, Contacts & Locator".
7. Review the [User Management](#) of your club, to ensure only current Committee Members have access to your clubs Database.

**Permit Workflow**—The LeagueNet Database will now prevent Permits unless an individual is First Registered in the 2017 Season at their Primary Club.

**Website/Mobile View Ability**—There has been an update of the view ability of Fixtures and Results on Mobile Devices. This will also be rolled out to webpages during October.

## POLi PAY is HERE!

POLi offers a great alternative to paying online with a credit card. With POLi, users can seamlessly and securely pay online by connecting to their bank. Payments that are made with POLi incur a processing fee charged by SportsTG. SportsTG are offering a special introductory rate of 2.7% (Inc. GST).

Note: Payments made with POLi are cheaper than payments made by VISA or Mastercard, due to the removal of merchant processing fees
